This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

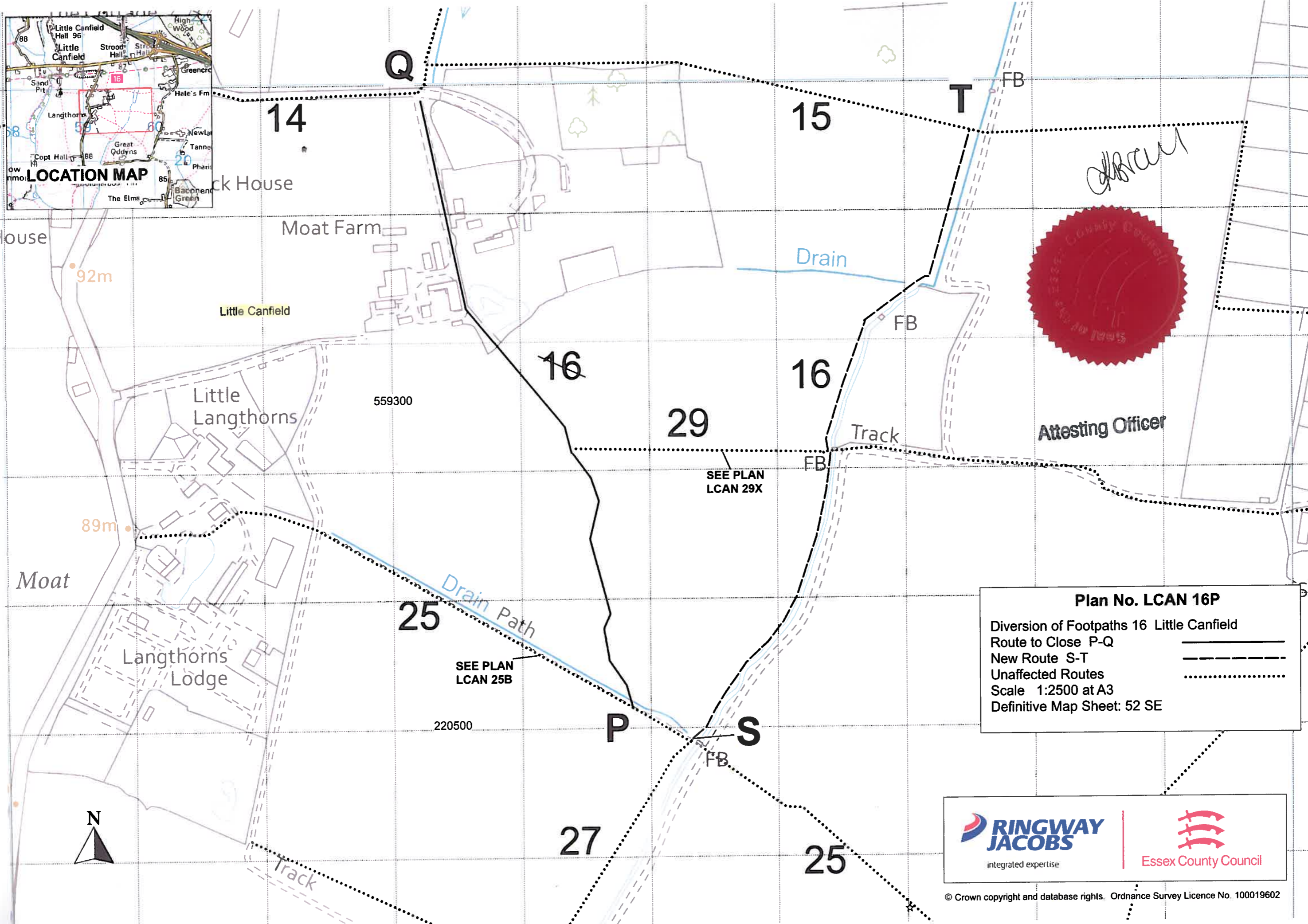
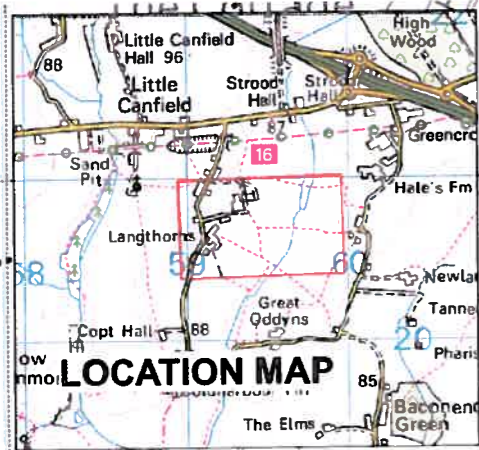
The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Uttlesford District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1) The public right of way over the land situated at Moat Farm known as Footpath 16 Little Canfield in the District of Uttlesford and shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map numbered LCAN 16P contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

- 2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated at Moat Farm known as Footpath 16 Little Canfield in the District of Uttlesford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken black line on the order map numbered LCAN 16P contained in this order.

SCHEDULE

(PART 1)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 16 Little Canfield of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from point **P** at grid reference 55948,22051 where it connects to Footpath 25 Little Canfield running in a generally north north westerly direction close to the buildings of Moat Farm for a total distance of approximately 525 metres to point **Q** at grid reference 55932,22099 where it connects to Footpath 14 Little Canfield.

(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at point **S** at grid reference 55953,22049 running in a generally north north easterly direction along the field boundary for a total distance of approximately 537 metres to point **T** at grid reference 55975,22096 where it connects to Footpath 15 Little Canfield.
