This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 118A of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”).

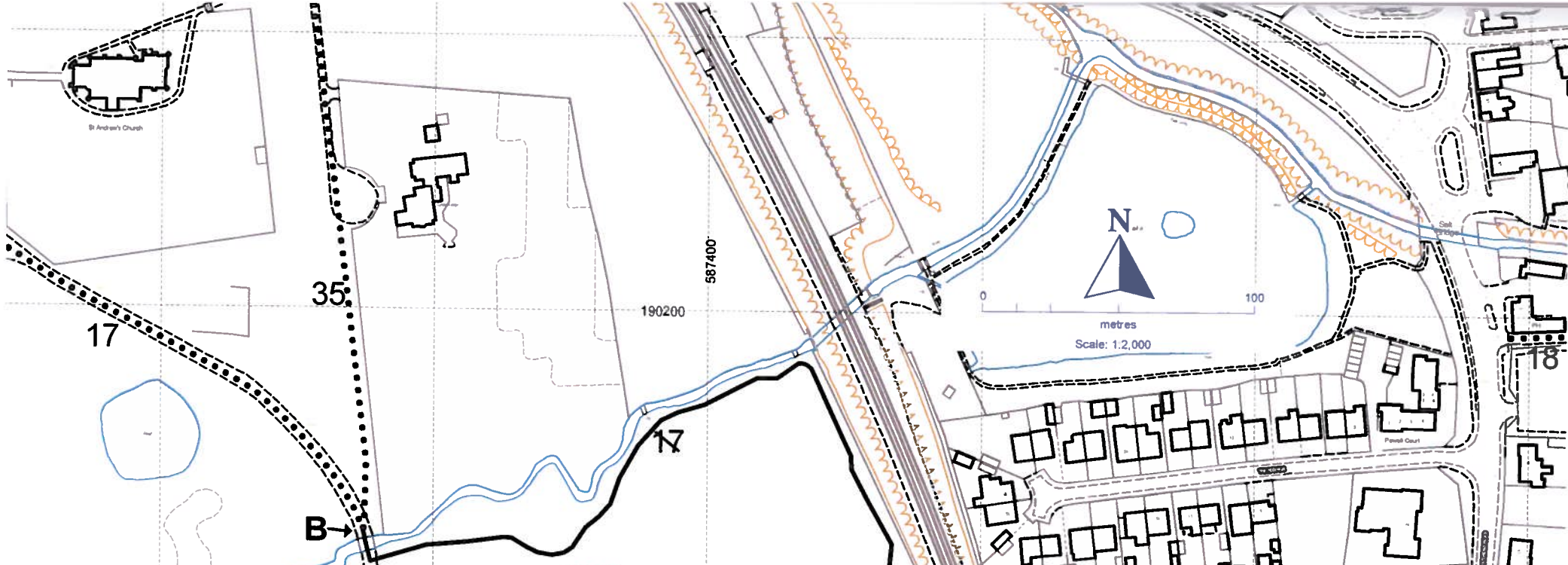
The footpath in the authority’s area described below crosses a railway otherwise than by a tunnel or bridge.

It appears to the authority that it is expedient in the interests of safety of members of the public using, or likely to use, the footpath that it should be stopped up.

Rochford District Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.


The operator of the railway Network Rail will erect and maintain barriers and signs at the crossing site.

THIS ORDER EXTINGUISHES the public right of way over the land situated west of Rochford Hall Close known as Footpath 17 Rochford in the District of Rochford and shown by a continuous bold line on the order map numbered PROW-19-38 attached to this order and described in the Schedule to this order shall be extinguished after 14 days from the date of confirmation of this order but Cadent/National Grid shall have the following rights over the land affected by this order namely:- the right, notwithstanding their rights under Paragraph 4, Schedule 12, Part II of the Highways Act, 1980, of access along the current route of Footpath 17 Rochford.

SCHEDULE

A part length of Footpath 17 Rochford of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 58753,19001 where it meets Rochford Hall Close east of the railway line running in a generally westerly direction across the railway line then across the golf course firstly in a north north westerly direction then meandering in a west north westerly then north north easterly direction around the edge of the pond then in a north north westerly direction adjacent to the railway line on the western side. The path then continues in a generally south westerly and finally generally northerly direction for a total distance of approximately 445 metres to point **B** at grid reference 58727,19011 at its junction with Footpath 35 Rochford where it continues unaffected
