



Project Completion Notification

Byway 61 Willingale Surface Improvement

SCHEME OBJECTIVE: The existing route with its status as Byway provides an off-road walking, cycling and horse riding, carriage driving and motorised vehicular opportunity for the local community and the public in general. This also forms a link to other footpaths.

The lane has become highly waterlogged and rutted despite a series of winter prohibitions and is very difficult to negotiate and could be preventing some use. Therefore the purpose of the scheme is to undertake improvement works (drainage and surfacing) to improve accessibility for all users.

SCHEME SUMMARY & OUTCOME: Infilling of ruts with suitable graded material and overlaying with road planings. Clearance of ditches and grips and creation of new ones. The outcome of the works is a much improved surface of this byway which allows for much safer passage of users along it.
