<u>Colchester Rapid Transit System –</u> <u>Final works schedule</u>

Dear Resident / Local stakeholder

We are writing firstly to apologise that the construction of the Rapid Transit System on Northern Approach Road has not been completed as per the timescale that had previously been indicated.

We appreciate that these works have been disruptive to residents and that you have shown great patience during the construction. The project is now at a very advanced stage and the final works that are required to bring the scheme to a conclusion have been identified.

The schedule for works that are remaining to be completed with an indication of potential impact and our mitigations is attached. The nature of the works we need to undertake means that a series of road closures at night will be required affecting Northern Approach Road, the Mill Road junction and Wallace and Dickenson Road. The full closures have been scheduled for 3rd April to 11th April. Additionally, lane closures will be in place during the night shift from the 14th to the 25th April.

We have included an FAQ overleaf to answer the questions you might have about these works.

We thank you for your co-operation and apologise for the temporary disruption as we approach the final stages of the project.

Northern Approach Road closures - FAQ

When will the closures happen?

The full closures have been scheduled to happen between the 3rd and 11th April, Monday to Friday only. No closures will happen on a weekend.

What time will the roads close?

The affected roads will be closed between 8pm and 11pm each weekday.

Which roads do you need to close?

The closures will affect different sections of Northern Approach Road, Mill Road, Wallace Road and Dickenson Road as identified on the attached schedule.

What works will you be undertaking during the closures?

Works remaining include, drainage, carriageway reinstatements, kerbing, surfacing, lining and loop cutting for the traffic signals. The new signals will also be commissioned with the temporary signals removed.

What is loop cutting?

In order to make all the traffic signals operational we need to install the sensors under the road surface which detects the movement of vehicles. This is called loop cutting and involves cutting slots in the road surface to embed sensors.

Why do you need to undertake these works at night?

Much of the works needed will involve excavating the carriageway which can only be done safely by closing the road. Northern Approach Road is the A134 and one of the main routes into Colchester. It is a traffic sensitive road so to close this during the day would have a significant impact on traffic across the city. The only viable option is to close the road at night when the traffic flows are lighter.

Will the works be noisy?

The loop cutting works require excavating which does involve noisy machinery. However, all the works will stop by 11pm to minimise disruption to the residents. Temporary traffic management will be removed from 11pm (this is not a noisy activity).


Will I be able to access my property during the closures?

Access for residents on the estate to the west of Northern Approach Road will be maintained. There will be three different traffic management arrangements in use which will determine which arrangements are in place for residents. Closures A and B involve the road being closed south of Wallace Road through to the Turner Road junction – Turner Road will remain open. Closure C will close Northern Approach Road from north of the Mill Road junction down to Dickenson Road. The dates for these are included on the schedule.
