

PROPOSED UPGRADE OF EXISTING PEDESTRIAN CROSSING – ST JOHNS ROAD, CLACTON ON SEA

Statement of Reasons

Summary of the Location

St Johns Road Clacton On Sea - The crossing is approximately 185 metres east of Constable Avenue on St Johns Road, Clacton On Sea.

Reasons for the Proposed Changes

Renewal of this Crossing is a part of a refurbishment programme of technology across Essex. The project involves replacing existing equipment with new Extra Low Voltage (ELV) LED technology. By using the latest technology, power savings and efficiency can be achieved.

The existing pedestrian signals (the red and green man display) are located on the far side of the crossing to indicate when a pedestrian may proceed to cross the road.

Benefits of the Proposed Changes

This renewal has provided an opportunity to revise the controlled pedestrian crossing at this location to comply with current guidance and Disability Discrimination Act best practice. To comply with these requirements, the proposed changes are shown on drawing number: 685616-04PX06-51-001
