

The Essex County Council (St Nicholas Street, Colchester) (One Way) Order 202*

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2) of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III to Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall except under the direction of a Police Constable in uniform cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of St Nicholas Street, in the Town of Colchester in the Borough of Colchester, specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in column 2 of the said Schedule.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the said length of road if the vehicle is being used for fire and rescue, police or ambulance purposes.
3. This Order shall come into operation on ***** and may be cited as The Essex County Council (St Nicholas Street, Colchester) (One Way) Order 202*
