

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Limebrook Way, and Ben Cobey Avenue, A414 Wycke Hill Roundabout) (20mph Zone & 40mph Speed Limit) Order 20**

The Essex County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road, various Roads, Limebrook Way, Maldon in the District of Maldon specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of Ben Cobey Avenue, Maldon in the District of Maldon specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. This Order may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Limebrook Way and Ben Coby Avenue) (20mph Zone & 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2020 and shall come into operation on *****.

Schedule 1 – 20mph Zone

Road	Description
Ben Cobey Avenue	From Its junction with A414 Wycke Hill roundabout from a distance of approximately 31 metres, east of the roundabout, for its entire length

Embleton Close	From its junction with Ben Cobey Avenue for its entire length.
Corbett Place	From its junction with Ben Cobey Avenue for its entire length.
Mons Way	From its junction with Ben Cobey Avenue for its entire length.

Schedule 2 – 40mph Speed Limit

Road	Description
Ben Cobey Avenue	From its junction with the A414 Wycke Hill Roundabout, eastwards for a distance of approximately 31 metres
