

# Public notice

**The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Limebrook Way, Ben Cobey Avenue, A414 Wycke Hill Roundabout) (20mph Zone & 40mph Speed Limit) Order 20\*\***

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) and Parts III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

**Effect of the order:** To introduce a 20 mph zone on the following lengths of roads:-

Road	Description
Ben Cobey Avenue	From Its junction with A414 Wycke Hill roundabout from a distance of approximately 31 metres, east of the roundabout, for its entire length
Embleton Close	From its junction with Ben Cobey Avenue for its entire length.
Corbett Place	From its junction with Ben Cobey Avenue for its entire length.
Mons Way	From its junction with Ben Cobey Avenue for its entire length.

To extend the existing 40mph speed limit on Ben Cobey Avenue, from its junction with the A414 Wycke Avenue roundabout, eastwards for a distance of approximately 31 metres.
