

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Byway13, Black Notley) (Seasonal Prohibition Of Driving) Order 20**

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Orders under Sections 1(1) to (2), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the orders:

1. To revoke the Seasonal Prohibition of Driving 1 November to 31 March, on the following length of Byways, Black Notley, in the District of Braintree

Name	Description
Byway 9 (Snakey Lane)	From a point approximately 50 metres northeast of the north-eastern boundary of the property known as Wrenn Park in a generally north-eastwards direction for approximately 1,750 metres to a point approximately 50 metres west of the junction with Witham Road.
Byway 10 (Green Lane)	From its junction with byway 9 (Snakey Lane) in a south-eastwards direction for a distance of approximately 650 metres to the parish boundary which is approximately 440 metres from the end of the non-classified road known as Green Lane.

'The Essex County Council (Various Byways, Black Notley) (Seasonal Prohibition of Driving) Order 1996 is hereby revoked. **The seasonal prohibition of driving will remain in force on Byway 13, Black Notley by virtue of this order.**
