The Essex County Council (Fairmead Road, Waltham Abbey/Loughton) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 20**

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III to Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. In this Order "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Essex County Council (Fairmead Road, Waltham Abbey/Loughton) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 20** and shall come into operation on
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the said length of Fairmead Road, Waltham Abbey/Loughton in the District of Epping Forest as specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this order [hereinafter referred to as the said length of road].
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any motor vehicle to proceed along the said length of road if the vehicle: -
 - (a) is being used for fire and rescue, police or ambulance purposes.
 - (b) is being used in connection with any of the following operations to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road, namely: -
 - (i) building or demolition.
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic.
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of those lengths of road.
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road, of any sewer, or any main, pipe of apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telegraphic line; or
 - (b) is being used in the service of or contracted to a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
 - (c) in any case where the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop or is obliged to do so to avoid an accident, or is

prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his/her control.

- 5. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 6. Pursuant to Section 10(2) of the Act, the Service Director, Development, Highways and Transportation may if it appears to him in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road affected by the Order runs, and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police, make modifications of any description (other than additions) to the Order or suspend the Order or any provision thereof.
- 7. The following Orders: Epping Forest District Council (Fairmead Road, Loughton) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1977 and The Essex County Council (Fairmead Road, Waltham Abbey) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 2013 are hereby revoked, as are all other Orders relating to the Prohibition of Motor Vehicles on Fairmead Road, Waltham Abbey.
