

**The Essex County Council (Various Roads, St Osyth)  
(30mph Speed Limit and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 202\***

The Essex County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(1) & (2)(a), 83(2), 84(1) and (2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") (as amended), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the said lengths of road, in the District of Tendring as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the said lengths of road, in the District of Tendring as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
5. This order shall come into operation on ..... and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads, St Osyth) (30mph Speed Limit and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 202\*.
6. 'The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (40mph Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order 2010' is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to those lengths of roads in the Parish of St Osyth, as specified in the Schedules to this Order.

**Schedule 1**

**'30mph Speed Limit' and 'Restricted Roads' in the Parish of St. Osyth.**

Road	Description
Clacton Road	From its junction with Nassau Road to its junction with Colchester Road.
Colchester Road	From a point 102 metres south of its junction with By-Pass Road southwards to its junction with Mill Street and Clacton Road, a total distance of approximately 588 metres.
Mill Street	From its junction with Colchester Road to its junction with Point Clear Road.
Point Clear Road	From its junction with Mill Street to its western termination, a total distance of approximately 4308 metres.

Spring Road / Beach Road	From a point 32 metres west of the centre of its junction with Daltes Lane eastwards then south-eastwards then southwards for approximately 298 metres.

## **Schedule 2**

**‘40mph Speed Limit’** in the Parish of St. Osyth.

<b>Road</b>	<b>Description</b>
B1027 Bypass Road	From a point approximately 180 metres east of its junction with Clacton Road, westwards to a point approximately 160 metres west of its junction with Clacton Road, for a total distance of approximately 340 metres.
B1027 Flag Hill, and B1027 Colchester Road	From its junction with B1027 Hollybush Hill southeast for approximately 510 metres, to a point approximately 30 metres southeast of its junction with Frowick Lane.
Clacton Road	From its junction with the B1027 Bypass Road, westwards for approximately 157 metres.
