

**The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Bentley, and St Osyth)
(Combined Speed Limits) Order 202***

The Essex County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(1) & (2)(a), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) (as amended), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on those lengths of road, in the Parish of Great Bentley, in the District of Tendring as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the said lengths of road, in the Parishes of Great Bentley, and St. Osyth, in the District of Tendring as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the said lengths of road, in the Parishes of Great Bentley, and St. Osyth, in the District of Tendring as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
5. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
6. This order shall come into operation on and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Bentley, and St Osyth) (Combined Speed Limits) Order 202*.
7. ‘The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Restricted Roads) (No.4) Order 2008’ is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to those lengths of road in the Parishes of Great Bentley, and St. Osyth, the restrictions in those Parishes shall remain in force by virtue of this new Order, all other roads not mentioned shall continue in force by virtue of the existing Order.
8. ‘The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (40mph Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order 2010’ is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to those lengths of roads in the Parishes of Great Bentley, and St. Osyth, the restrictions in those Parishes shall remain in force by virtue of this new Order, all other roads not mentioned shall continue in force by virtue of the existing Order.
9. ‘The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Bentley) (20mph Zone, Restricted Roads and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2024’ is hereby revoked in its entirety. All restrictions shall remain in force by virtue of this new Order.

Road	Description
Michael Wright Way	From its junction with Heckfords Road for its entire length.
Pump Lane	For its entire length.
Hills Close	For its entire length.

(ii) From a point 150 metres northwest of its junction with Weeley Road south-eastwards to approximately 50 metres southeast of the centre of its junction with St Mary's Road, a total distance of approximately 675 metres.

30mph Speed Limit - Lengths of road at Great Bentley.

Road	Description
Heckfords Road	From its junction with Weeley Road and Thorrington Road northwards, for approximately 536 metres, to a point approximately 92 metres north of the extended kerb line of Moors Close.
Weeley Road	From its junction with Heckfords Road and Thorrington Road, eastwards for approximately 750 metres, to where it meets the boundary of Great Bentley Parish and National Speed Limit sign.

‘30mph Speed Limit’ and ‘Restricted Roads’ in the Parish of St. Osyth.

Road	Description
Clacton Road	From its junction with Nassau Road to its junction with Colchester Road.
Colchester Road	From a point 102 metres south of its junction with By-Pass Road southwards to its junction with Mill Street and Clacton Road, a total distance of approximately 588 metres.
Mill Street	From its junction with Colchester Road to its junction with Point Clear Road.
Point Clear Road	From its junction with Mill Street to its western termination, a total distance of approximately 4308 metres.
Spring Road / Beach Road	From a point 32 metres west of the centre of its junction with Daltes Lane eastwards then south-eastwards then southwards for approximately 298 metres.

Schedule 3

40mph Speed Limit - Lengths of road at Great Bentley.

Road	Description
B1027 Hollybush Hill	From a point approximately 20 metres southeast of its junction with Dial Road, south-eastwards for approximately 1,000 metres to its junction with Dead Lane.
B1027 Flag Hill	From its junction with B1027 Hollybush Hill, and Dead Lane, south-eastwards for approximately 150 metres, to its junction with the B1027 Flag Hill St. Osyth Parish.
Plough Road	From a point approximately 150 metres northwest of its junction with Weeley Road, Aingers Green, northwest for approximately 520 metres.

‘40mph Speed Limit’ in the Parish of St. Osyth.

Road	Description
B1027 Bypass Road	From a point approximately 180 metres east of its junction with Clacton Road, westwards to a point approximately 160 metres west of its junction with Clacton Road, for a total distance of approximately 340 metres.
B1027 Flag Hill, and B1027 Colchester Road	From a point approximately 150 metres east its junction with B1027 Hollybush Hill, and Dead Lane, south-eastwards for approximately 550 metres, to a point approximately 220 metres southeast of its junction with Frowick Lane.
Clacton Road	From its junction with the B1027 Bypass Road, westwards for approximately 157 metres.
