

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Bentley, and St. Osyth) (Combined Speed Limits) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under S82(1) & (2)(a), 83(2), 84(1) and (2), and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

Effect of the order: To Introduce: a '40mph Speed Limit' (an existing National Speed Limit Road) in the Parishes of Great Bentley, and St. Osyth.

Road	Description
B1027 Flag Hill, Great Bentley	From its junction with B1027 Hollybush Hill, and Dead Lane, south-eastwards for approximately 150 metres, to its junction with the B1027 Flag Hill St. Osyth Parish.
B1027 Flag Hill, and B1027 Colchester Road, St Osyth	From a point approximately 150 metres east its junction with B1027 Hollybush Hill, and Dead Lane, south-eastwards for approximately 550 metres, to a point approximately 220 metres southeast of its junction with Frowick Lane.

'The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (40mph Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order 2010' and 'The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Restricted Roads) (No.4) Order 2008' are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to those lengths of road in the Parish of St. Osyth, the restrictions in those Parishes shall remain in force by virtue of the new Order, all other roads not mentioned above shall continue in force by virtue of the existing Orders. 'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Bentley) (20mph Zone, Restricted Roads and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2024' is hereby revoked in its entirety. All restrictions shall remain in force by virtue of the new Order.
