

**The Essex County Council (Church Street, Bocking)  
(30mph Speed Limit) Order 202\***

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") (as amended), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the said length of road, Bocking, in the District of Braintree, as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
4. This order shall come into operation on ..... and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Church Street, Bocking) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 202\*.
5. The Essex County Council (Church Street, Bocking) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2002 is hereby revoked in its entirety.
