The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.30)

**Notice is hereby given** that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

## **Effect of the Order:**

New Access	BOTH SIDES:
Bellmouth/side	From its junction with Stephenson Road southwards for an approximate
Road	distance of 4 metres
