The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Little Clacton) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") (as amended), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the said lengths of road, in the District of Tendring as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 3. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. The Essex County Council ((Tendring District) (40mph Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order 2010' is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length of roads at Little Clacton however, all 40mph Speed Limits in Little Clacton shall continue in force by virtue of this new Order.
