'The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (40mph Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order 2010' is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length of roads at Little Clacton however, all 40mph Speed Limits in Little Clacton shall continue in force by virtue of this new Order.
