

**The Essex County Council (Brentwood Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.21) Order 202\***

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

Vehicles regularly park outside of the parade of shops in Rayleigh Road, Hutton, which are situated to the west of Mount Pleasant Avenue. There is no distinction between the shop fronts, the footway and the parking area (or even if it is an official parking area). As a result, vehicles regularly park all over the area in question, which obscures the view for drivers attempting to leave Mount Pleasant Avenue. There are a few bollards in the corner of the junction, but they are not sufficient to prevent the issue from occurring. The County Member has therefore requested that consideration be given to introducing additional bollards on the corner of the junction, as well as considering whether there are any additional options that could be considered to improve the parking situation outside of the shops. This proposal is for No Waiting at Any Time Restrictons to be installed.
