

**The Essex County Council (Cottis Lane, Epping)
(Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 202***

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”), in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (2) and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This order shall come into operation on ** ***** **** and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Cottis Lane) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 202*.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any motor vehicle to be in “the said length of road” if the vehicle: -
 - (a) Is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods, or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to “the said length of road”.
 - (b) is being used in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the roads, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those roads, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of those roads, or the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to those roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.
 - (c) is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
 - (d) is being used in an emergency for Fire and Rescue, Police, or Ambulance purposes;
4. No restrictions imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
5. The Council are satisfied that for facilitating the passage of vehicular traffic on the road for which the order relates, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act should not apply in relation to this Order.
6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
