The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.36) Order 202*

The Essex County Council (Old Gas Works Retail Park, Old Road, Clacton-on-Sea) (Prohibition of Left-Hand Turn) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the Order:

1. To Revoke: 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions

Road	Description
Old Road	WEST SIDE: From a point in line with the boundary of property numbers 56 and 58 Old Road, south for approximately 13 metres.

2. To Implement: 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions

Road	Description
Old Gas Works Retail Park, Old Road	BOTH SIDES: From its junction with Old Road, west for approximately 6 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into 'The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019' by substituting map tile: TM170 147 Revision 0 to Revision 1.

3. To Implement: 'Prohibition of Left-Hand Turn' Restriction

No person shall cause any vehicle leaving the Old Gas Works Retail Park to make a left-hand turn in order to travel northbound on Old Road.
