

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Brentwood Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 24) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

Effect of the order: To revoke the existing 'Disabled Badge Holders Only Bay' on the following length of roads, in the Borough of Brentwood.

Road	Description
Chase Road, Brentwood	<u>EAST SIDE:</u> From a point approximately 1 metre south of the common boundary of properties 33 & 35 Chase Road, south for an approximate distance of 5 metres. Confirm ref: 2808761
Gresham Road, Brentwood	<u>NORTH-EAST SIDE:</u> From a point in line with the common boundary of properties 20 & 22 Gresham Road, in a south easterly direction for an approximate distance of 5 metres. Confirm ref: 2835126
Rowan Green East, Brentwood	<u>EAST SIDE:</u> From a point approximately 0.7 metres north of the southern property boundary of 21 & 22 Rowan Green East, north for an approximate distance of 5 metres. Confirm ref: 2825706

To Implement 'Disabled Badge Holders Only' bay on the following length of road, in the Borough of Brentwood.

Road	Description
Hampden Crescent, Warley	<u>NORTH SIDE:</u> From a point approximately 1.8 metres east of the western property boundary of 14 Hampden Crescent in a westerly direction for an approximate distance of 5 metres. Confirm ref: 2803150

To Implement 'Residents Permit Holders Only C Mon-Sat 8am-6pm' restrictions on the following length of road, in the Borough of Brentwood.

Road	Description
Chase Road, Brentwood	<u>EAST SIDE:</u> From a point approximately 1 metre south of the shared property boundary of 33 & 35 Chase Road, south for an approximate distance of 5 metres. Confirm ref: 2808761

To Implement 'Residents Permit Holders Only C Mon-Fri 9am-5pm' restrictions on the following length of road, in the Borough of Brentwood.

Road	Description
Gresham Road, Brentwood	<u>NORTH-EAST SIDE:</u> From a point in line with the shared boundary of properties 20 & 22 Gresham Road, in a south easterly direction for an approximate distance of 5 metres. Confirm ref: 2835126
