

**The Essex County Council (Cowper Crescent, Myland)
(One-Way) Order 202***

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under S1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) (as amended), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Save as provided in Article 2, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to travel on the road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, in a direction other than that as specified in Column 2 of the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply if the vehicle is being used for Fire and Rescue, Police or Ambulance purposes.
3. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
4. This order shall come into operation on ***** and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Cowper Crescent, Myland) (One-Way) Order 202*.
