The Essex County Council (Castle Point Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 13) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the order:

To Revoke: 'Disabled Badge Holders Only' Bay.

The Firs, Canvey Island	NORTH SIDE: From a point approximately 1.2 metres north east of the boundary of property numbers 1 and 3 The Firs, north eastwards for approximately 2.5 metres. ParkMap Tile: TQ785 840 - Revision 0 to Revision 1
Vicarage Close, Canvey Island	SOUTH SIDE: From a point approximately 8.5 metres south east of its junction with Haven Road, south eastwards for approximately 6.9 metres. ParkMap Tile: TQ775 830 - Revision 0 to Revision 1
