The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Little Easton) (30mph and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1)(a) and (2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") (as amended), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on those lengths of road, Little Easton, in the District of Uttlesford as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on those lengths of road, Little Easton, in the District of Uttlesford as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 3. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 5. 'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Little Easton) (30MPH & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 2018' is hereby revoked in its entirety. The restrictions contained within that Order shall continue in force by virtue of this new Order.
