

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Little Easton) (30MPH & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 2018

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on those lengths of roads, Little Easton in the District of Uttlesford as specified in schedule 1 to this order.
2. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on those lengths of Duck Street, Little Easton in the District of Uttlesford as specified in schedule 2 to this order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.
4. This Order shall come into operation on 31 October 2018 and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Little Easton) (30MPH & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 2018.
5. 'The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Restricted Road) Order 2006' is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to lengths of roads in Little Easton only. All other restrictions will remain in force.

Schedule 1 – 30MPH

| Road | Description |
|---------------------------------|---|
| Butchers Pasture, Little Easton | From its junction with Duck Street north-eastwards for its entire length, a distance of approximately 132 metres. |
| Duck Street, Little Easton | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. From a point approximately 63 metres west of the public footpath No.26, Little Easton north-westwards to a point approximately 10 metres northwest of the northern boundary of property known as Ripley. ii. From the projected north western kerb line of Park Road westwards for a distance of approximately 38.5 metres. |
| Manor Road, Little Easton | From its junction with Duck Street south-westwards for its entire length, a distance of approximately 185 metres. |
| Mill End, Little Easton | From its junction with Park Road eastwards to a point approximately 35 metres southeast of the eastern boundary of the property known as Little Martins, a distance of approximately 416 metres. |
| Park Road, Little Easton | From a point approximately 125 metres east of property No.1 Park Road, westwards for a total distance of approximately 370 metres. |

Schedule 2 – 40MPH

| Road | Description |
|----------------------------|---|
| Duck Street, Little Easton | From a point approximately 63 metres west of the centre of public footpath No.26, Little Easton south-eastwards to a point approximately 38.5 metres north west of the projected north western kerb line of Park Road (Measured along the northern kerb line of Duck Street). |
