

# Public notice

## The Essex County Council (Various Roads, (Turpins Farm) Frinton And Walton) (20mph Zone) Order 202\*

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 84(1)(a) and (2), and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

### Effect of the orders:

**To Implement:** 'a '20mph Zone' on the following length of roads, in the District of Tendring

Road	Description
Blackthorn Avenue	From a point approximately 6 metres west from the centre of the junction with Elm Tree west for approximately 366 metres
Samphire Way	From its eastern junction with Blackthorn Avenue, north then both east and west, for its entire length including private drives and turning heads ending at its western junction with Blackthorn Avenue. (Approximately 106 metres)
Aspen Close	From its junction of Blackthorn Avenue, south then west for its entire length including private drives and turning heads. (Approximately 105 metres)
Cherry Avenue	From its junction with Aspen Close, west for its entire length including private drives and turning heads. (Approximately 292 metres)
Jasmine Close	From its junction with Cherry Avenue south for its entire length including private drives and turning heads. (Approximately 49 metres)
Bracken Way	From its junction with Blackthorn Avenue north then both west and east for its entire length including private drives and turning heads. (Approximately 121 metres)
Hazel Avenue	From its eastern junction with Blackthorn Avenue north then west for its entire length including private drives and turning heads ending at the western junction of Blackthorn Avenue. (Approximately 335 metres)
Rowan Way	From its junction with Hazel Avenue north west then east for its entire length including private drives and turning heads. (Approximately 65 metres)
