

# Public notice

**The Essex County Council (Colchester City) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.66) Order 202\***  
**Pedestrian Crossings – Boxted Road, Safrano Avenue, and Whitmore Drive, Myland, Colchester**

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1),45, 46, 49, 53, and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

**Effect of the order:**

**1. To Revoke:** ‘No Waiting at Any Time’ Restrictions.

Road	Description
Whitmore Drive	<b>Both Sides:</b> From its junction with Boxted Road, east for approximately 28.5 metres.

**2. To Revoke:** ‘No Stopping at Any Time on Verge or Footway’ Restrictions.

Road	Description
Boxted Road	<b>West Side:</b> From the northern kerb line of Safrano Avenue to the southern kerb line of Safrano Avenue, approximately 6 metres.

**3. To Relocate:** ‘No Stopping Except for Buses’ Restrictions.

Road	To Remove	To Implement
Boxted Road	<b>East Side:</b> From a point approximately 18 metres south of its junction with Whitmore Drive, south for approximately 13 metres.	<b>East Side:</b> From a point approximately 33 metres south of its junction with Whitmore Drive, south for approximately 13 metres.

**4. To Implement:** a ‘No Stopping Except for Buses’ Restriction.

Road	Description
Boxted Road	<b>West Side:</b> From a point approximately 67.5 metres north of its junction with Safrano Avenue, north for approximately 13 metres.

**5. To Implement:** ‘No Stopping on Main Carriageway - 24hr Clearway’ Restriction.

Road	Description
Safrano Avenue	<b>Both Sides:</b> From its junction with Boxted Road, west for approximately 36 metres.
Whitmore Drive	<b>Both Sides:</b> From its junction with Boxted Road, east for approximately 28.5 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into ‘The Essex County Council (Colchester Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019’ by substituting map tiles: TL985 285 Revision 1 to Revision 2, TL990 285 Revision 0 to Revision 1

Under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (as amended), Essex County Council proposes to establish and upgrade Pedestrian Crossings on Boxted Road, Safrano Avenue, and Whitmore Drive, in the City of Colchester located as follows.

**6. To Implement:** a 'Signalised Pedestrian Crossing'

Road	Description
Boxted Road (north of Whitmore Drive)	The centre line of the crossing is approximately 6.5 metres north of its junction with Whitmore Drive.
Safrano Avenue	The centre line of the crossing is approximately 6 metres west of its junction with Boxted Road.

**7. To upgrade:** an existing 'Uncontrolled Crossing to Toucan Crossing'

Road	Description
Whitmore Drive	The centre line of the crossing is approximately 5.5 metres east of its junction with Boxted Road.

**8. To Implement:** a 'Toucan Crossing'

Road	Description
Boxted Road (south of Whitmore Drive)	The centre line of the crossing is approximately 11 metres southwest of its junction with Whitmore Drive.
