

# Public notice

**The Essex County Council (Colchester City) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.69) Order 202\***  
**Implementation of a Zebra Crossing on Bowes Road**

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under S1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 23, 32(1), 35(1),45, 46, 49, 53, and Parts IV and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

**Effect of the order:**

- 1. To Revoke:** ‘No Stopping Mon-Fri 8.30am-9.30am and 2.30pm-3.30pm On Entrance Markings’

Road	Description
Bowes Road, Wivenhoe	<b>NORTH SIDE:</b> From a point approximately 3 metres east of its junction with Amberley Close, east for approximately 60 metres. <b>SOUTH SIDE:</b> From a point approximately 6 metres east of its junction with Amberley Close, east for approximately 68 metres.

- 2. To Revoke:** ‘No Waiting Mon-Fri 8.30am-9.30am and 2.30pm-3.30pm’ Restrictions.

Road	Description
Amberley Close, Wivenhoe	<b>BOTH SIDES:</b> From its junction with Bowes Road, northwest for approximately 9 metres.
Bowes Road, Wivenhoe	<b>NORTH SIDE:</b> From its junction with Amberley Close west for approximately 5 metres. <b>EAST SIDE:</b> From a point approximately 11 metres south of its junction with Rectory Hill and Alresford Road, south for approximately 7 metres.

- 3. To Revoke:** ‘No Waiting at Any Time’ Restrictions and **Implement:** ‘No Stopping at Any Time – Red Route’ Restrictions.

Road	Description
Bowes Road, Wivenhoe	<b>BOTH SIDES:</b> From its junction with Rectory Hill and Alresford Road, south for approximately 11 metres.
Rectory Hill, Wivenhoe	<b>SOUTH SIDE:</b> From its junction with Bowes Road west for approximately 12 metres.
Alresford Road, Wivenhoe	<b>SOUTH SIDE:</b> From its junction with Bowes Road east for approximately 11 metres.

- 4. To Implement:** ‘No Stopping – Red Route Mon-Fri 8.15am-9.15am and 2.45pm-3.45pm’ Restrictions.

Road	Description
Amberley Close, Wivenhoe	<b>NORTHWEST SIDE:</b> From the extended northern kerb line of Milford Close northeast for approximately 34 metres. <b>NORTH SIDE:</b> From the extended eastern kerb line of Amberley Close, east for approximately 31 metres. <b>EAST SIDE:</b> From a point approximately 11 metres south of its junction with Rectory Hill and Alresford Road, south for approximately 7 metres.

	<p><b>SOUTHEAST SIDE:</b> From a point approximately 56 metres south of its junction with Rectory Hill and Alresford Road, southwest for approximately 23 metres.</p> <p><b>SOUTH SIDE:</b> From a point approximately 9 metres southwest of the southern kerb line of Milford Close, northeast and east for approximately 79 metres.</p> <p><b>WEST SIDE:</b></p> <p>(i) From a point approximately 11 metres south of its junction with Rectory Hill and Alresford Road, south for approximately 63 metres.</p> <p>From the extended southern kerb line of Milford Close, south for 9 metres.</p>
Bowes Road, Wivenhoe	<p><b>NORTHWEST SIDE:</b> From the extended northern kerb line of Milford Close northeast for approximately 34 metres.</p> <p><b>NORTH SIDE:</b> From the extended eastern kerb line of Amberley Close, east for approximately 31 metres.</p> <p><b>EAST SIDE:</b> From a point approximately 11 metres south of its junction with Rectory Hill and Alresford Road, south for approximately 7 metres.</p> <p><b>SOUTHEAST SIDE:</b> From a point approximately 56 metres south of its junction with Rectory Hill and Alresford Road, southwest for approximately 23 metres.</p> <p><b>SOUTH SIDE:</b> From a point approximately 9 metres southwest of the southern kerb line of Milford Close, northeast and east for approximately 79 metres.</p> <p><b>WEST SIDE:</b></p> <p>(ii) From a point approximately 11 metres south of its junction with Rectory Hill and Alresford Road, south for approximately 63 metres.</p> <p>(iii) From the extended southern kerb line of Milford Close, south for 9 metres.</p>
Milford Close, Wivenhoe	<p><b>BOTH SIDES:</b> From its junction with Bowes Road, northwest for approximately 9 metres.</p>

This Order will be incorporated into 'The Essex County Council (Colchester Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019' by substituting Map Tile: TM045 220 Revision 0 to Revision 1.

Under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (as amended), Essex County Council proposes to establish a Zebra Crossing on Bowes Road, in the City of Colchester located as follows.

**5. To Implement:** a 'Zebra Crossing'.

The Centre Line of the crossing is located approximately 54 metres east of the junction with Amberley Close.

The width between give way lines is approximately 5.8 metres.

Zigzags for the above Zebra Crossing will be installed on Bowes Road approximately 18 metres either side of the zebra crossing, for the width of the road.
