2. To Implement: a '50mph Speed Limit' Reference TRAF8602

A1025 Gilden Way Link	Westbound carriageway: From the Western Dumbbell
Road (Westbound),	Roundabout, west for approximately 651 metres, to the
Sheering	junction with the Campions Roundabout.

3. To Implement: a 'Derestriction' Reference TRAF8603

Road	Description
A1025 Gilden Way Link	Both carriageways: To include the circulatory of both
Road (Dumbbell	roundabouts and the connecting road. Approximately 235
Roundabouts), Sheering	metres.

'The Essex County Council (B183 (to become the A1025) Gilden Way/Sheering Road, Harlow/Sheering) (40MPH Speed Limit) (No.2) Order 2019' is hereby revoked in its entirety, all restrictions shall remain in force by virtue of the new Order.

'The Essex County Council (Sheering) (40mph & 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2003' is hereby revoked in its entirety, all restrictions shall remain in force by virtue of the new Order.
