

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Brentwood Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.29) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, and Parts IV and III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended),

Effect of the order

1. To Revoke: 'Disabled Badge Holders Only' Bay.

Road	Description
Beech Avenue	Northeast Side: From a point in line with the boundary of properties 46 and 48, northwest for approximately 5.5 metres.

2. To Revoke: 'Disabled Badge Holders Only' Bay

to Implement: 'Resident Permit Holders Only D Mon-Fri 9am-5pm' Restrictions.

Road	Description
Sussex Road	West Side: From a point in line with the boundary of properties 8 and 9, north for approximately 5 metres.

3. To Revoke: 'Resident Permit Holders Only A Mon-Sat 9am-6pm' Restrictions

to Implement: 'Disabled Badge Holders Only' Bay.

Road	Description
North Road Avenue	West Side: From a point approximately 10 metres south of its junction with North Road, south for approximately 5 metres.

4. To Upgrade: 'Existing Advisory Bay' to Enforceable: 'Disabled Badge Holders Only' Bay.

Road	Description
Lime Avenue	East Side: From a point in line with the extended boundary line of No.27 Lime Avenue north for approximately 5 metres.
Stocks Lane	Southwest Side: From a point in line with the boundary of properties 14-16, southeast for approximately 10 metres.
