

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Various Roads (East of Bromley Road) Lawford) (20mph Zone) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 84(1)(a) and (2), and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

Effect of the order: To Implement: a '20mph Zone' on the following length of roads, including any turning heads and private drives

Road	Description
The Avenue	From a point approximately 20 metres east of its junction with Bromley Road, for its entire lengths, to a point approximately 20 metres south of its junction with the B1352 Long Road.
Sienna Grove	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire length.
Lennox Drive	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire length.
Tavistock Place	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire length.
Somerset Gardens	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire length.
The Hollies	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire length.
Hebe Gardens	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire lengths.
Rose Fields	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire length.
William Way	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire length.
Pax Drive	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire length.
The Ramblings	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire length, to its junction with Amelia Drive.
Amelia Drive	From its junction with Hebe Gardens, for its entire length, to its junction with Ellis Walk.
Ellis Walk	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire length.
Barleylands	From its junction with Ellis Walk, for its entire length.
Badger Grove	From its junction with Ellis Walk, for its entire length.
Skylark Lane	From its junction with The Avenue, for its entire length, to its junction with Rose Fields.
The Shrublands	From its junction with Skylark Lane, for its entire length.
