

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.79) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

Effect of the Order:

1. To Revoke: 'No Stopping Mon-Fri 8am-4pm On Entrance Markings'

Road	Description
Brookside	South Side: From a point approximately 31 metres west of the western kerb line of Katherines Primary School's main entrance (former access point) (opposite Church End Western junction), to a point approximately 31 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Katherines Primary School's main entrance.

2. To Implement: 'No Stopping - Red Route Mon-Fri 8am-4pm' Restrictions (Single Red Line)

Road	Description
Brookside	South Side: From a point approximately 13 metres northwest of the northern kerb line of Church End (Eastern junction), northwest for approximately 121 metres.

3. To Implement: 'No Stopping Mon-Fri 8am-4pm On Entrance Markings' (School Keep Clear)

Road	Description
Brookside	West Side: From a point approximately 12 metres south of the southern kerb line of Church End (Eastern junction), northwest for approximately 32 metres.

4. To Implement: 'No Stopping at Any Time – Red Route' Restrictions (Double Red Lines)

Road	Description
Church End (Eastern junction)	Both Sides: From its junction with Brookside, east for approximately 16 metres.
Brookside	East Side: From a point 16 metres north of its junction with Church End (Eastern junction) to a point 16 metres south of its junction with Church End (Eastern junction).

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting map tile: TL430 085 Revision 1 to Revision 2.
