The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.35) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, and Parts IV and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

To Implement: 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions

Road	Description
Robin Hood Road, Elsenham	West Side: (i) From the southern extended kerb line of Rush Lane, south for approximately 99 metres. (ii) From the southern extended kerb line of Marian Way, south for approximately 20 metres. East Side: From a point approximately 10 metres north of its junction with Rush Lane, south for approximately 136 metres (including the tarmacked area leading to the pedestrian's controlled-access zone (railway line)).
Rush Lane, Elsenham	Both Sides: From its junction with Robin Hood Road, west for approximately 12 metres.
Marian Way, Elsenham	Both Sides: From its junction with Robin Hood Road, west for approximately 9 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into 'The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019' by substituting map tiles: TL530 257 and TL530 260 Introducing Revision 0.
