## The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.34) Order 202\*

## The Essex County Council (Various Roads (Northeast of Clifford Smith Drive) Felsted) (20mph Zone) Order 202\*

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 84(1)(a) and (2), and Parts IV and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

### Effect of the order:

#### 1. To Implement: 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions

Road	Description
Clifford Smith Drive	<b>East Side:</b> (i) From a point in line with the northern kerb line of Nightingale Way northwest for approximately 32.5 metres. (ii) From a point in line with the southern kerb line of Nightingale Way southeast for approximately 10 metres.
Nightingale Way	<b>Both Sides:</b> From its junction with Clifford Smith Drive, northeast for approximately 15 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into 'The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019' by Introducing map tile: TL690 212 Revision 0

#### 2. To Implement: a '20mph Zone' including Private Roads, in Felsted, Uttlesford

Road	Description
Nightingale Way	From its junction with Clifford Smith Drive, for its entire length.
Wren Gardens	From its junction with Nightingale Way, for its entire length.
Linnet Place	From its junction with Nightingale Way, for its entire length.
