

The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.34) Order 202*

The Essex County Council (Various Roads (Northeast of Clifford Smith Drive) Felsted) (20mph Zone) Order 202*

STATEMENT OF REASONS:

No Waiting at Any Time Restrictions

The site - located at Clifford Smith Drive, Felsted is a residential road with an existing 20mph speed limit.

These proposals will cover the junction with Nightingale Way.

The proposals are to introduce No Waiting at Any Time parking restrictions (double yellow lines), to prevent vehicles from parking and obscuring visibility when exiting the junction.

By preventing parking at this location, it is hoped that these lines will improve visibility for all users. This will also facilitate the safe manoeuvrability of refuse vehicles and larger delivery vehicles entering and exiting the junction.

20mph Zone

As a new development in accordance with the Essex Design Guide a '20mph Zone' will be applied to the above lengths of road. This will facilitate a safer pedestrian environment and improve safety for all residents, children, and visitors to the area.

It is Essex County Council's policy that new housing estate roads are constructed to ensure, as far as is possible, that vehicle speeds are 20mph or below. This is done via the introduction of a 20mph zone and a variety of physical measures.

The roads on this estate have been constructed in accordance with this policy and a 20mph zone is proposed to reinforce the physical measures which includes bends, and ramps.

These proposals will be funded solely by the developer, with no associated costs to the Highway Authority.
