**The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Newport, Stansted Mountfitchet, Ugley, Wendens Ambo, Great Chesterford, Littlebury, Quendon, and Rickling) (Combined Speed Limits) Order 202\***

**Proposed Implementation of a Toucan Crossing on Bury Lodge Lane**

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under S81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2), and Parts IV and III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

**Effect of the order: To Implement:** a '50mph Speed Limit' (Currently a National Speed Limit Road)

Road	Description
Bury Lodge Lane	From a point approximately 100 metres northwest of its junction with the roundabout at Round Coppice Road, Roman Lane, and First Avenue, northwards for approximately 800 metres.

'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Newport, Stansted Mountfitchet, Ugley, Quendon and Rickling) (Combined Speed Limit) Order 2021' is hereby revoked in its entirety, however, the restrictions in the said Order shall remain in force by virtue of the new Order.

**Notice is also hereby given that:** Under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (as amended) the Essex County Council proposes to establish a Toucan Crossing on Bury Lodge Lane, Stansted Mountfitchet, Uttlesford.

The Centre Line of the crossing is located approximately 30 metres north of the tangent point of the northern kerb line serving the Secondary Car Park Access.

The width between give way lines is approximately 9 metres.

Zigzags for the above Toucan Crossing will be installed on Bury Lodge Lane approximately 25 metres either side of the crossing, for the width of the road.
