ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (MAYNE CREST / PUMP LANE, CHELMSFORD) CYCLE TRACK ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Essex County Council has made an Order under Section 3(1) of the Cycle Tracks Act 1984 to convert the footpath described below into a designated cycle track including a right of way for pedestrians. The Order requires confirmation before it comes into operation and the conversion works can take place.

The conversion is shown on the plan annexed to the Order entitled "Pump Lane Toucan Crossing Cycle Track Order 2026", drawing number B3553A46-EHF-LSI-SEC14-DR-CH-0002 Rev A, where the route is indicated by green honeycomb hatching.

FOOTPATH TO BE CONVERTED:

The entire length of the existing footpath measuring approximately 31.0 metres in length and 3.1 metres in width connecting Mayne Crest and Pump Lane, Chelmsford.

FURTHER DETAILS:

A copy of the Order, the statement of reasons and the plan showing the footpath to be converted may be inspected, free of charge, during normal office hours at Chelmsford Library, County Hall, Market Road, Chelmsford CM1 1QH.
