

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Colchester City) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.80) Order 202*

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Colchester City) (20mph Speed Zone) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the order below under S1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

SCHEDULE:

1. To Implement: 20mph Speed Zone Restrictions – Including Private Drives

Road	Description
Poultry Close	From its junction with John Flower Avenue, South East for its entire length.
Flock Drive	From its junction with Poultry Close, West for its entire length
Hen Way	From its junction with John Flower Avenue, East for its entire length
Brood Chase	From its junction with John Flower Avenue, West for its entire length
Fouracre Field	From its junction with Brood Chase, West for its entire length

2. To Implement: 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions.

Road	Description
John Flower Avenue	Both Sides: From its junction with Halstead Road, North for its entire length (approximately 373 metres) ending at its junction with Fiddlers Hill.
Poultry Close	Both Sides: From its junction with John Flower Avenue, South East for approximately 9.5 metres.
Brood Chase	Both Sides: From its junction with John Flower Avenue, West for approximately 6 metres.
Hen Way	Both Sides: From its junction with John Flower Avenue, East for approximately 6.5 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Colchester City) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting map tile: TL930 262 Rev 0 – Rev 1 and Introducing Tiles: TL930 260 and TL930 265.
