## Proposed Upgrade of an existing Zebra Crossing, to a Signalised (Puffin) Pedestrian Crossing, High Road, Rayleigh in the District of Rochford

**Notice is hereby** given that under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) the Essex County Council proposes to upgrade of an existing Zebra Crossing, to a Signalised (Puffin) Pedestrian Crossing on High Road, Rayleigh in the District of Rochford

**Effect of the Proposal: To Upgrade:** an existing Zebra Crossing to a signalised Puffin Crossing

Location of the crossing centre line	At a point approximately 27 metres north of the centre line of Love Lane
Width between stop lines:	Approximately 6 metres
Length of zigzags	Approximately 17 metres either side of the crossing.
