

**The Essex County Council (Rectory Lane, Rivenhall, Witham)  
(Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 202\***

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”), in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. In this Order  
“motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act.
2. This Order shall come into operation on\*\*\*\*\* and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Rectory Lane, Rivenhall, Witham) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 202\*.
3. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed along Rectory Lane, Rivenhall, Witham, in the District of Braintree, as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. The Council are satisfied that for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the roads to which the Order relates or any other road and for preventing damage to the road or to any buildings on or near it, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act should not apply in relation to this Order.
5. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
