The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.59) Order 202*

The Essex County Council (Rectory Lane, Rivenhall, Witham) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Orders under sections (1), 2(1) to (4), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53, and Parts IV and III of Schedule 9 of the Road Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the orders:

1. To Implement: 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions.

Road	Description
Rectory Lane Turning Head, Rivenhall, Witham	From its junction with Rectory Lane, (at a point approximately 209 metres north of its junction with Forest Road) for its entirety.

This Order will be incorporated into 'The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019' by Introducing map tiles: TL820 165 and TL825 165 Revision 0.

2. To Implement: 'Prohibition of Motor Vehicles' Restriction.

Road	Description
Rectory Lane, Rivenhall, Witham	From its junction with Forest Road, north for approximately 202 metres.
