

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Basildon Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.53) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the order:

1. To Revoke: 'No Stopping Mon-Fri 8.30am-9.30am and 2.30pm-3.30pm on entrance markings.

Road	Direction
Hickstars Lane	South East Side: From a point on the extended northern kerb line of Kennel Lane north east for approximately 83 metres

2. To Revoke: 'No Waiting Mon-Fri 8am-6pm'

Road	Direction
Hickstars Lane	North West Side: From a point approximately 37 metres north east from the extended northern kerb line of Kennel Lane, north east for approximately 25.5 metres.

3. To Implement: 'No Stopping Mon-Fri 8am-9.30am and 2.30pm-4pm'

Road	Direction
Hickstars Lane	North West Side: From a point approximately 37 metres north east from the extended northern kerb line of Kennel Lane, north east for approximately 25.5 metres. South East Side: From a point on the extended northern kerb line of Kennel Lane north east for approximately 83 metres

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Basildon Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting tiles: TQ680 930 Revision 1 to Revision 2 and TQ680 932 Revision 1 to Revision 2
