## Proposed Upgrade of an existing Pelican Pedestrian Crossing on North Station Road, in the City of Colchester.

### Essex County Council (Colchester City) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.81) Order 202\*

**Notice is hereby given that** the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

#### Effect of the Order:

##### 1. To Revoke: 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions on the following:

Road	Description
North Station Road	<b>Both Sides:</b> From a point approximately 15 metres south of the extended southern kerb line of John Harper Street, south for approximately 5 metres

##### 2. To Implement: 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions on the following:

Road	Description
North Station Road	<b>West Side:</b> From a point approximately 53 metres south of the extended southern kerb line of John Harper Street, south for approximately 1.5 metres

This Order will be incorporated into the 'Essex County Council (Colchester Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019' by substituting map tiles: TL990 257 revision 2 to Revision 3

**Notice is also hereby given that** under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) the Essex County Council proposes: **To Implement:** an Upgrade of the current Pelican Crossing to a Pedex Crossing on the following length of North Station Road.

Location of the crossing centre line	At a point approximately 36.5 metres south of the extended southern kerb line of John Harper Street
Width between Stop lines:	Approximately 8.5 metres
Length of zigzags	North of Crossing - approximately 17.5 metres South of Crossing - approximately 13.5 metres
