The Essex County Council (A131 Mount Hill, A131 Bournebridge Hill, and Oak Road, Halstead) (Combined Speed Limits) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 81, 82(1) & (2) (b), 83(2), 84(1)(a) and (2), and Parts IV and III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

Effect of the order:

To Extend: a '40mph Speed Limit' on the following length of road, Halstead.

Road	Description
A131 Mount Hill / A131 Bournebridge Hill	From a point approximately 54 metres southwest of its junction with Russell's Road, southwest for approximately 287 metres.

'The Essex County Council (A131 Mount Hill and Oak Road, Halstead) (Restricted Road & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 2022' is hereby revoked in its entirety, however, all restrictions not mentioned above shall remain in force by virtue of this Order.
