

**The Essex County Council (Mulberry Avenue, Cressing)
(7.5 Tonne Weight Limit) Order 202***

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) (as amended) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause any vehicle having a maximum permissible gross weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes to proceed along the length of roads, in the Parish of Cressing, in the District of Braintree, as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in any of the roads referred to in that Article, if the vehicle.
 - a) is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods, or merchandise to or from any premises on or adjacent to the roads affected by the Order.
 - b) is being used for the purposes of agriculture on those roads or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land.
 - c) is being used in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the roads, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those roads, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of those roads, or the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to those roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.
 - d) is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
 - e) is being used in an emergency for Fire and Rescue, Police, or Ambulance purposes; or
 - f) is a stage carriage (as defined by Section 117(1) of The Road Traffic Act 1960)
3. The Council are satisfied that for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the roads to which the Order relates or any other road and for preventing damage to the road or to any buildings on or near it, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act should not apply in relation to this Order.
4. This order shall come into operation on ***** and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Mulberry Avenue, Cressing) (7.5 Tonne Weight Limit) Order 202*.

7.5 Tonne Environmental Weight Limit Except for Access' Restriction.

Road	Description
Mulberry Avenue (New Link Road)	From the B1018 Braintree Road Roundabout for its entire length, approximately 579 metres, to the Long Green and Mulberry Avenue Roundabout.
Fir Drive	From its junction with Mulberry Avenue. For its entire length.
Pine Road	From its junction with Mulberry Avenue. For its entire length.
Cherry Tree Way	From its junction with Mulberry Avenue. For its entire length.
Alder Place	From its junction with Mulberry Avenue. For its entire length.
Cedar Road	From its junction with Mulberry Avenue. For its entire length.
