

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Halstead) (Restricted Road and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*

The Essex County Council (Edwards Avenue, Halstead) (20mph Zone) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) (a) and (2) and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The Effect of the Order:

- 1. To Implement** - a '40mph Speed Limit' Restriction on the following length of road - currently a derestricted road (**TRAF/8087**)

Road	Description
Tidings Hill	From a point approximately 13 metres southwest of its junction with Grange Close (where the existing 30mph speed limit ends) south west for approximately 146 metres.
Edwards Avenue	From its junction with Tidings Hill north west for approximately 7 metres.

'The Essex County Council (A131 Mount Hill and Oak Road, Halstead) (Restricted Road and 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 2022' is hereby revoked in its entirety however, any roads not mentioned above shall continue in force by virtue of this new Order.

- 2. To Implement** – a '20mph Zone' Restriction on the following length of roads: (**TRAF/8473**)

Road	Description
Edwards Avenue	From a point approximately 7 metres northwest of its junction with Tidings Hill, for its entire length, including any private drives and turning heads.
Fairman Way	From its junction with Edwards Avenue for its entire length including any private drives and turning heads for approximately 72.5 metres.
Jubilee Close	From its junction with Edwards Avenue for its entire length including any private drives and turning heads for approximately 180 metres.
