

Public notice

The Essex County Council (A134 Northern Approach, Colchester) (Two-Way Bus Lane) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that further to a notice on the 21 November 2024, Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 84 (1)(a) and (2) and Part III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the Order:

1. **To Revoke:** The Essex County Council (Northern Approach, Colchester) (Bus Lane) Order 2025 in its entirety
2. **To Implement:** Bus Lane (Two-Way) '**Permitting Local Buses Only**' restrictions.

Road	Description
A134 Northern Approach Road Busway	From its junction with Mill Road north for approximately 110 metres.
A134 Northern Approach Road Busway	From its junction with Mill Road south to its junction with Dickenson Road, approximately 313 metres.
A134 Northern Approach Road Busway	From its junction with Dickenson Road south to its junction with Wallace Road, approximately 472 metres.
A134 Northern Approach Road Busway	From its junction with Wallace Road south to its junction with Bruff Close, approximately 407 metres.
