

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Colchester City) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 62) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

Effect of the Order:

- 1. To Revoke** 'Residents Permit Parking Area C1' and **Implement** 'Disabled Badge Holders Only' bay restrictions on the following length of road in the City of Colchester

Road	Description
Fairfax Road	SOUTH SIDE: From a point in line with the property boundary of 15 and 17 Fairfax Road, east for approximately 5 metres.

- 2. To Upgrade:** 'Disabled Badge Holders Only' bays on the following lengths of road:

Road	Description
Beche Road	NORTHEAST SIDE: From a point in line with the boundary of 26 and 28 Beche Road, northwest for approximately 5.5 metres.
Devon Road	SOUTHWEST SIDE: From a point in line with the western boundary of 32 Devon Road, west for approximately 2.5 metres (Length Approximately 5.5 metres).
New Park Street	EAST SIDE: From a point approximately 1 metre south of the northern boundary of 24 New Park Street, south for approximately 4.5 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into 'The Essex County Council (Colchester Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019' by substituting map tiles:
