

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on B175 Stapleford Road, Stapleford Abbotts, in the District of Epping Forest, from the A113 Ongar Road/A113 London Road/B175/Albyns Lane roundabout, generally southeast, for a distance of approximately 1910 metres.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on B175 Stapleford Road, Stapleford Abbotts, in the District of Epping Forest, from a point approximately 60 metres northwest of the northern arm of Gutteridge Lane, generally southeast, to a point approximately 166 metres northwest of the junction with Bournebridge Lane, a distance of approximately 685 metres.
- 3. The Essex County Council (B175 Stapleford Road, Stapleford Abbotts) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 is hereby revoked.
- 4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on 15 February 2013 and may be cited as The Essex County Council (B175 Stapleford Road, Stapleford Abbotts) (40mph and 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2013.

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on those lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 2. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on those lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.
- 4. The Essex County Council (Bournebridge Lane, Hoe Lane, Hook Lane, Manor Road & New Road, Lambourne/Stapleford Abbotts) (Restricted Road & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 2014 is hereby revoked, the restrictions contained within that order shall continue in force by virtue of this order.
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on 3 April 2015 and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Bournebridge Lane, Hoe Lane, Hook Lane, Manor Road & New Road, Lambourne/Stapleford Abbotts) (30MPH & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 2015.
