

**The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Stapleford Abbots)
(40mph Speed Limit) Order 202***

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) (a) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") (as amended) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the lengths of road, in the Parish of Stapleford Abbots, in the District of Epping Forest as specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
2. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of road, in the Parish of Stapleford Abbots, in the District of Epping Forest as specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.
4. 'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Stapleford Abbots) (Restricted Roads) Order 2007' is hereby revoked in its entirety however, all restrictions shall continue in force by virtue of this new Order.
5. 'The Essex County Council (B175 Stapleford Road, Stapleford Abbots) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2007' is hereby revoked in its entirety however, all restrictions shall continue in force by virtue of this new Order
6. 'The Essex County Council (B175 Stapleford Road, Stapleford Abbots) 40mph and 50mph Order 2013 is hereby revoked in its entirety however, all restrictions shall continue in force by virtue of this new Order.
7. "The Essex County Council (Bournebridge Lane, Hoe Lane, Hook Lane, Manor Road & New Road, Lambourne/Stapleford Abbots) (30mph & 40mph Order 2015 is hereby revoked in its entirety however, all restrictions shall continue in force by virtue of this new Order.
8. This Order shall come into operation on _____ and may be cited as The Essex County Council (B175 Stapleford Road, Stapleford Abbots) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*

Schedule 1 - 30mph

Road	Description
B175 Oak Hill Road	From a point approximately 166 metres north west of the junction with of Bournebridge Lane in a south easterly direction to the boundary of the London Borough of Havering, a distance of 1452 Metres.
Bournebridge Lane	From its junction with B175 Oak Hill Road for a distance of approximately 400 metres in a south westerly direction.
Tysea Hill	From its junction with B175 Oak Hill for distance of approximately 480 metres in a north easterly direction.
Hoe Lane, Lambourne	From its junction with Manor Road in a generally north western direction, for a distance of approximately 95 metres.
Manor Road, Lambourne	From the south western boundary of Berkeley Cottage in a generally north eastern direction for a distance of approximately 750 metres

Schedule 2 - 40mph

Road	Description
B175 Stapleford Road	From the A113 Ongar Road, A113 London Road, B175, Albyns Lane Roundabout, generally southeast for a distance of approximately 2570 metres to the junction with Blenheim Mews.
Bournebridge Lane, Lambourne/ Stapleford Abbots	i. From its junction with Hook Lane/ Manor Road in a generally south eastern direction, for a distance of approximately 50 metres. ii. From a point approximately 10 metres south west of the south western boundary of Bourne View in a generally western direction for a distance of approximately 910 metres
Hoe Lane, Lambourne	From a point approximately 95 metres north of its junction with Manor Road, in a generally north westerly direction for an approximate distance of 835 metres
Hook Lane, Lambourne/Stapleford Abbots	From its junction with Manor Road in a generally north eastern direction, for a distance of approximately 20 metres
Manor Road Lambourne/ Stapleford Abbots	From its junction with Hook Lane/ Bournebridge Lane in a generally western direction for approximately 550 metres, then in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 40 metres. A total length of approximately 590 metres
New Road, Lambourne	From its junction with Hoe Lane, generally east then south east to its junction with Manor Road
